



East and West Kauai SWCD Poster Contest Eligibility and Rules

1. Any K-6th grade student can participate
2. The poster should be either 8.5" x 11" **OR** 11" x 17" in size
3. Material must be a poster using any media that results in a flat (2D) product. (eg. Paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, stickers, paper, etc).
 - a. **NO tape, staples or fluorescent colored paper**
4. Posters are to be made by individual students rather than teams
5. Entry must be contestant's original creation and may not be traced from photographs or other artists' published works.
6. Each poster submitted **must have** an entry form **signed** by a parent or guardian. If a poster is not signed, then we cannot judge it or send it to the national contest nor can we display it.
7. Posters need to be packaged in a way that they remain flat when sent in.
8. The 2019 title "Life in the Soil: Dig Deeper" **must be included on the front of the poster.**
9. We encourage that most of the work be done by the student themselves, but adult assistance is allowed, though the more that is done by the student the better the poster will do in judging
10. Posters are due no later than **Monday September 23rd 2019.** (either delivered to the Lihue Office or pick-up can be arranged with the conservation specialist)

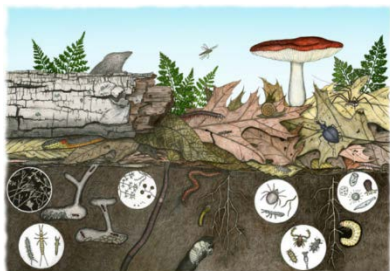
